



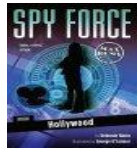

[The Lost Island of Tamarin](#) by Nadia Agular

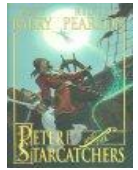

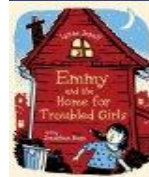
This prequel to the adventures of **James Bond**, 007, introduces us to the young James when he's just started boarding school in England and is about to become involved in his first adventure.

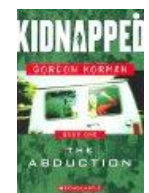

Aiden works with the FBI in order to rescue his sister Meg, who was kidnapped.

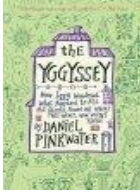

[The Yggyssey: How Iggy Wondered What Happened to all the Ghosts, Found out Where They Went, and Went There](#) by Daniel Pinkwater

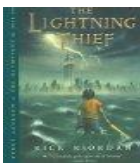

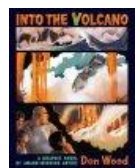
The classic tale is transformed into a graphic novel with all of the original exploits and adventures.
