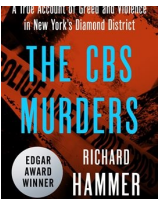


### **Three Sisters in Black** Zierold, Norman

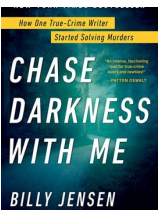

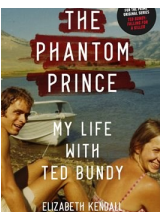

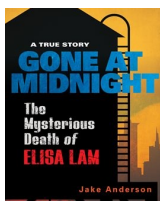
